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PENETAPAN PINTU MASUK BAGI PERKHIDMATAN TEKSI AIR DAN LARANGAN MENGADAKAN AKTIVITI SOSIAL MARIN DI WILAYAH PERSEKUTUAN LABUAN

ESTABLISHMENT ENTRY POINT FOR WATER TAXIES SERVICES AND PROHIBITION FOR MARINE SOCIAL ACTIVITY AT LABUAN FEDERAL TERRITORY

Masyarakat perkapalan telah dimaklumkan melalui Perutusan Khas YB Menteri Kanan Pertahanan mengenai COVID-19 pada 2 Februari 2021, berkaitan dengan situasi ancaman virus COVID-19 yang semakin serius. Bagi mencegah penularan baharu wabak ini, Kerajaan telah memutuskan untuk melaksanakan lanjutan Perintah Kawalan Pergerakan (PKP) di Wilayah Persekutuan Labuan mulai 5 Februari 2021 sehingga 18 Februari 2021 di bawah Akta Pencegahan dan Pengawalan Penyakit Berjangkit 1988 dan Akta Polis 1967.

Selaras dengan lanjutan PKP tersebut, Terminal Feri Antarabangsa Labuan ditetapkan sebagai pintu masuk utama bagi semua perkhidmatan teksi air yang membawa anak kapal atau penumpang yang berlabuh di perairan Wilayah Persekutuan Labuan untuk tujuan saringan kesihatan berkuatkuasa sehingga 18 Februari 2021.

Masyarakat perkapalan juga tidak dibenarkan untuk mengadakan sebarang aktiviti sosial marin seperti *Parasailing, Sunset Cruise, Island Hopping, Diving, Snorkeling* dan apa jua aktiviti sosial yang berkaitan di laut sehingga 18 Februari 2021.

Shipping community has been informed that in accordance with the Senior Minister of Defense Special Message regarding to COVID-19 on February 2th 2021, in relation to the increasingly serious situation of the COVID-19 virus. To prevent the spread of the pandemic, the Government has decided to implement the extension of Movement Control Order (MCO) at Labuan Federal Territory commencing from February 5th 2021 until February 18th 2021 which under the Prevention and Control of Infectious Diseases Act 1988 and the Police Act 1967.

In line with the extension of MCO, Labuan International Ferry Terminal designated as the main entrance for all water taxis services carrying crews and passengers anchored in the Labuan Federal Territory waters for health screening purposes effective until February 18th 2021.

Shipping community also are not permitted to conduct any marine social activities at sea such as Paraisailing, Sunset Cruise, Island Hopping, Diving, Snorkelling and any relevant marine social activities until February 18th 2021.
